



Hot Peppers

Anaheim TMR	(OP) long, tapered, mild pungency, medium thick walls, green turns deep red
Ancho 101	THE pepper for Chiles Rellanos, makes a dark mild chile powder when dried, mildly pungent flavor with a hint of apple.
Cayenne Long Slim	(OP) excellent for pickling and sauces, mild pungency, easily dried
Cherry Bomb	matures from green to red, use in both stages, med. hot, thick walled, can or pickle
Cubanelle	popular frying pepper, yellow-green maturing to red, pleasant taste
Garden Salsa	excellent for Mexican style "salsa", very flavorful but not too hot, heavy yields
Gypsy Hybrid	(T F, Hybrid) unusual wedge shape, gold turning red, sweet, ideal for eating fresh
Habanero	HOTTEST PEPPER IN THE WORLD, 100 times hotter than a jalapeno, thin walled fruit, turns green to orange, wrinkled
Hungarian Sweet	long, tapered fruit, heavy producer, yellow ripens to red
Jalapeno	(OP) very hot fruit, deep green turns to red, 3" long, 1" diameter, blunt end
Jalapeno Tam	(OP) mild jalapeno flavor but not as much fire, excellent for freezing and canning
Inferno Hot Banana	just hot enough to taste good with everything, 8" x 1 1/2" fruit
Mexibelle	(Bell) zesty, mild chili flavor, 3-4 lobed.
Pasilla Bajio	(T) mild, unique flavor with berry and herbal overtones, strong upright plant, narrow, long, black-green chillies ripen to a raisin brown, use fresh or dried
Senorita	mildly spicy, jalapeno flavor, 3" long fruit, smooth dark green skin
Serrano Grande	(Hybrid) vigorous growth, 2-3" long, matures dark green to red, fiery
Super Chili	VERY HOT, extra early, 2 1/2" fruit, very prolific
Thai Dragon	8 x's hotter than standard jalapeno, high yields, 3 1/2" long fruit
Tabasco Greenleaf	HOT, slim, yellow-green, bullet shaped

Sweet Peppers

Bell Boy	(T F ₁ Hybrid Bell) early, large 4-lobed fruit with thick walls, green matures to red
Chocolate Beauty	(T F ₁ Hybrid Bell) matures to an attractive chocolate color
Early California Wonder	(Bell) prolific, 4-lobed, upright fruit, thick, sweet and mild
Golden Summer Hybrid	(T, F ₁ Hybrid Bell) earlier and more productive than other golden peppers, 4-lobed ripen from light lime green to bright golden yellow
Peppourri Orange	(Hybrid Bell) dark green fruit ripens orange, thick walls, high vitamin content
Purple Beauty	(OP Bell) compact plant, medium-sized, dark purple, add color and flavor to salads
Red Beauty	(T Hybrid Bell) thick walled, blocky 4" long, heavy yields, red, sweet

T=Tobacco Mosaic Virus resistant F1=A hybrid cultivar OP=An open-pollinated (non-hybrid) center
