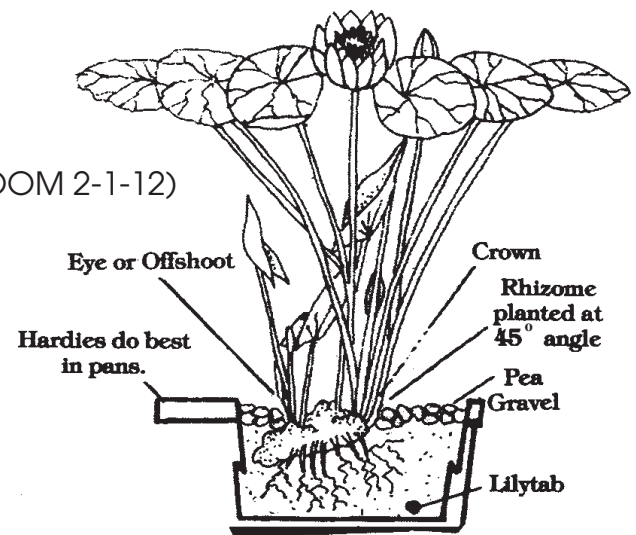


POTTING HARDY WATER LILIES

You will need:

- Plastic soil container (10 qts. or larger)
- Rich garden soil (top soil)
- Plant food (we recommend Tetra Pond LILY BLOOM 2-1-12)
- Pea gravel



Procedure:

1. Fill container 1/2 full of soil
2. Add recommended dosage of plant food.
3. Add enough soil to fill container to 3/4 full.
4. Position the plant. Plant against one edge of container, with rhizome at a 45 degree angle, so lilies will grow across planting container.
5. Gently add soil around roots and firm in. Keep growing crown free of soil.
6. Thoroughly saturate soil with water.
7. Cover soil with a layer of pea gravel, 1/2-1", again keeping the crown free.
8. Carefully lower completed planter into pool to a depth of 6". Water lilies start best in shallower depths and can be lowered to 18" after good growth is established.
9. Water lilies require 2-4 weeks adjustment before new growth resumes.
10. For best blooming results, feed at 2-3 monthly intervals during growing season.
